Entries must include copies of all required membership cards as well as a copy of a current coggins test. **Refunds:** Before CD, entry and stabling refunded less 15% administration fee; after CD, 50% of entry & stabling refunded, with vet or medical certificate. **No refund after June 29.** **NOTE:** Fax entries are accepted – provided copies of membership cards and coggins test are included and payment is received on or before CD. Entries or payments received after CD – are subject to a \$ 30.- surcharge if accepted.

**4) STABLING:** \$ 30.-/ night (US\$ 26.-). Choice of Main Stable, Summer Stable or Arena Stalls – first come / first served. Initial bedding provided. Feed/Hay available for sale.

**5) DRESSAGE:** I – 2005 IHT Test A ; P – 2005 PHT Test A; T – 2005 CET Test C-40; PT – 2005 PT Test A; S – 2005 E Test A. **ARENAS:** I & P 20x60m; T, PT & S 20x40m. Sand footing.

**6) CROSS-COUNTRY:** I – 3500m @ 550mpm; P - 3000m @ 520mpm; T - 2500m @ 450mpm; PT - 2250m @ 400mpm; S - 2000m @ 325mpm.

TERRAIN: EXCELLENT ALL WEATHER FOOTING - over undulating open fields and wide trails. Some new fences. Stadium: All weather sand footing.

**9) DIRECTIONS:** From Montreal: Autoroute #10 east to exit # 121 – Autoroute #55 south to exit #21. Hwy 141 south through village of Ayers Cliff to intersection with Hwy 143. Continue from this point for 7.3 km (4.5 mi) on Hwy 141 to Roy Rd. N – turn left and continue for 3 km (2 mi) to Turtle Hill Farm. From USA: Interstate 91 north to US/Can. border – continue north on Autoroute 55 to exit # 2 (1.5 mi). Hwy 143 north to intersection with Hwy 141 (13 mi). From this point (143/141) follow the same directions as above.

**10) OTHER INFORMATION:** Vet., medical, blacksmith and food on grounds. Majority of property open for recreational riding. Opportunity for canoeing, swimming or fishing. **Complimentary “Wine & Cheese Party”** – Saturday evening. (Two free tickets per entry – additional tickets \$ 15.-, soft drinks available).
